

*Memorandum of Understanding*

*The Japanese Society of International Law*  
*And*  
*The Korean Society of International Law*

*October 22, 2016*

This Memorandum of Understanding is concluded between The Japanese Society of International Law (JSIL) of Japan and The Korean Society of International Law (KSIL) of the Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties").

The Parties are linked by common academic interests, in particular the goal of promoting research and education in the field of international law;

The Parties intend to strengthen cooperation and exchange in all academic areas of mutual interest;

The Parties desire to expand the basis for friendship and educational exchange between each other; and

The Parties have agreed as follows:

**OBJECTIVE**

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to establish a formal relationship of cooperation which allows the promotion of international law research and education.

**AREAS OF COOPERATION**

The purposes of this Memorandum of Understanding include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (a) The development of collaborative projects on international law;
- (b) The development of materials on international law;

- (c) The exchange of publications and other materials of common interest; and
- (d) Cooperation for nurturing international law experts.

#### LIMITATION

This Memorandum of Understanding does not create any contractual rights or obligations.

#### DURATION AND ENTRY INTO EFFECT

This Memorandum of Understanding comes into effect upon signature, and will remain in effect for three years. After the initial period of three years, either Party may terminate the Memorandum by giving six months' prior notice of such intent in writing. Termination of this Memorandum will not in any way affect the projects or arrangements which have already been under way pursuant to this Memorandum.
